Ladybirds have been working hard this week. They particularly enjoyed the Science day, where we carried out a variety of Science experiments and activities.

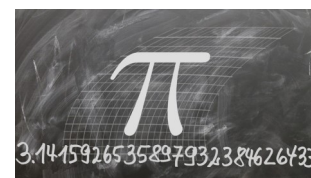
We were also very lucky to have experienced a Science Show, which the children really enjoyed.
