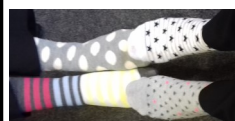

Tettenhall Fire Station offering FREE Lifesaving course Tuesday 3rd April 2018, 6pm – 8pm

Tettenhall Fire Station are offering residents the chance to attend a free lifesaving course presented by FastAid, who provide part of the first response to the West Midlands Ambulance Service.

The course is also supported by West Midlands Fire Service, with the aim to provide confidence for people to assist until one of the emergency services can get to the person needing help.

This course will cover CPR, dealing with an unconscious casualty, choking, control of major bleeding and using an AED (defibrillator).
